President's Report (Jeff Carpenter):

Jeff expressed the need for parents' time and energy to help revitalize the foundation. The Hall of Fame event will be held around homecoming time.

Alicia Haun, a RBHS student is working on having a TEDx talk held on campus. She has requested help from the foundation if the need arises. The foundation is willing to help as needed. Jeff is looking into how the foundation can be a sponsoring organization for the Presidential Volunteer Service Award.

A question was presented to Jeff about what the foundation does, and Denise explained how the foundation has evolved over time, Jill communicated the need to make a lasting impression on RBHS and Peggy expressed the need to be a community school. All these things won't happen overnight, but we would like to give it our best effort.

The district has a hydration station that was meant for Meadowbrook that is not being used. It's blue, sitting in the district warehouse ready to install. Dave asked the foundation to divide the cost of the station with PTSA. The foundation board approved \$2225.00 for the hydration station.
